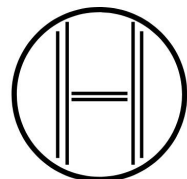
"Blessed is the man who trusts in the Lord, And whose hope is the Lord." Jeremiah 17:7

FBC **KIDS**

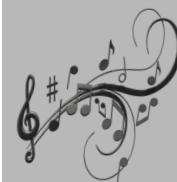
